All OK. SH has nothing to report.

EYXC

Wetwang next race. 10am start. A decent ladies team is required. Nothing to report All seems to be going well.

Ferriby 10. A debrief.

LK reported that a complaint had been received from a representative of ERYC. She reported that a large number of runners had been urinating in the entrance road to the Skidby Mill Cafe.

It was explained that this was due to a lack of portaloo toilets at the start and at the HQ, which was an oversight on our behalf. She was advised that the runners are briefed at the start of the race about such behaviour. An apology was given on behalf of the club and agreed that it was unacceptable. She was told that Portaloos would be

available for next years race, both at the start and the HQ.

A couple of complaints were received about the lack of toilets, which has been addressed.

Tee shirts. These were well received. The only issue being that a whole box of XS tee shirts was not located and those who had ordered an XS took anther size, which caused problems. This was an oversight. It was a positive improvement having people put their size on the entry form. This resulted in not many spare tee shirts left over. LK is trying to arrange a replacement for those who received the wrong size.

Road closures. These were discussed, there were a couple of issues around this matter but nothing major. Eppleworth continues to be a difficult place to marshal, with no natural pavement for the marshal to stand. Otherwise all went well and KS did an excellent job of coordinating.

A cut off point was discussed. It was clear that due to handful of very slow runners, and one runner in particular who walked from the 5 mile point, it was causing unnecessary difficulties for marshals and the road closure system. Road closures are authorised for a certain length of time, and once the road is re opened we cannot guarantee the safety of runners left behind. A decision was made to discuss the option of a cut off point for next years race. It will be discussed how long to allow for the completion of the race.

A discussion took place about raising the entry fee for next years race in order to cover the costs of portaloos and tee shirts. This would still be in line with other race entries of that distance and it would help us to increase the prize money, which has stayed the same for a few years.

It was discussed that if the prize money for the first three men and women was raised significantly, it would attract a good standard of athletes to the race and heighten the profile of the race. This is to be discussed further.

Yorkshire Wolds relays

PC explained that there is enough interest for three teams. This equates to 2 mens teams and 1 ladies team. The cost for a team entry is fifty pounds, which the club have agreed to subsidise. The event takes place on Sunday 21st May 2020. LK will captain the ladies and PC will captain the mens. They will recce the course and work out change overs etc. Information will be provided and a group chat will be produced.
